ST MARK'S UPDATE #5

As mentioned in our last update, a group of about a dozen St Peterites are meeting three times this month with an equivalent group from St Mark's; this is an initial getting-to-know-each-other exercise as programmed by the diocesan facilitator, the Rev Ralph Leavitt. A report on these meetings will be provided to both congregations by Rev Leavitt. Next month there will be two meetings open to all members of both congregations, to explore common vision and mission. These will be the morning of Saturday May 12, and the afternoon of Saturday May 26, at St Mark's. (Specific start times still TBA). After these two meetings there will be opportunity for follow-up discussion among ourselves as members of St Peter's.
